The Strategy's investment universe formally consists of all North American listed equity securities with market caps greater than \$3 B at the time of initial purchase.

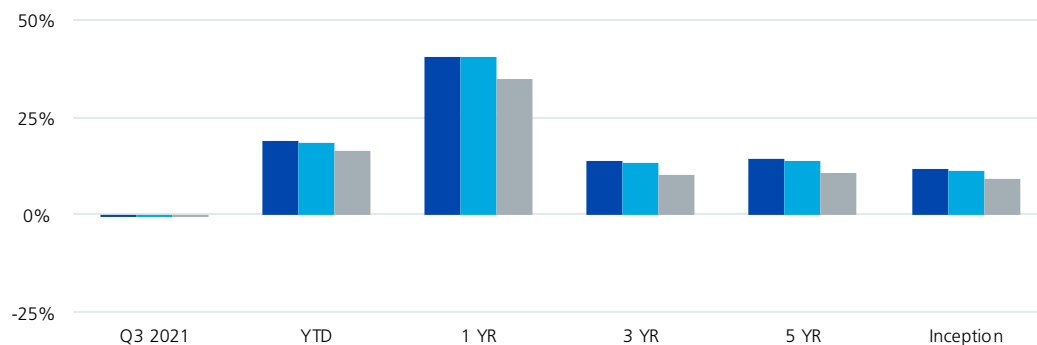

Market Highlights

- A volatile quarter ended with mixed returns for stocks.
- Large cap and growth outperformed for the quarter; value and large cap lead year to date.
- Within the Russell 1000 Value index, **Financials (+2.46%)** and **Real Estate (+2.24%)** posted the highest total returns, while **Materials (-4.98%)** and **Industrials (-3.83%)** posted the lowest.

Portfolio Highlights

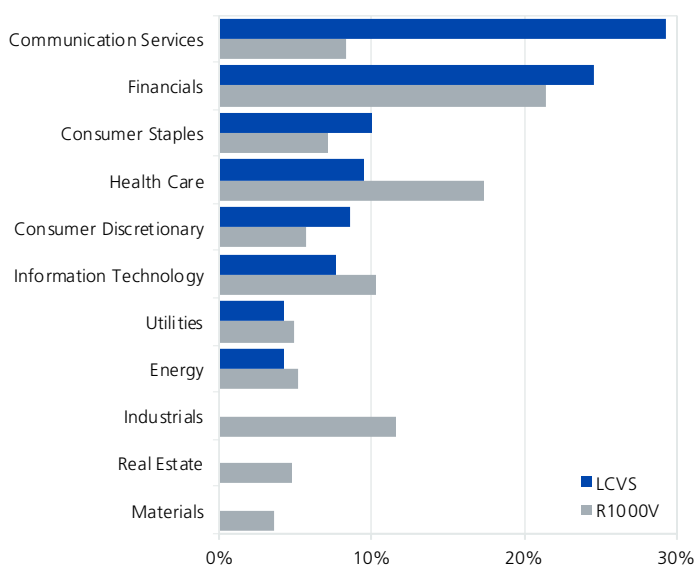
- The River Road Large Cap Value Select (LCVS) Composite returned **-0.45%** (-0.48% net) for Q3 versus **-0.78%** for the Russell 1000 Value benchmark. Year to date, the Composite returned **+18.79%** (+18.59% net) versus **+16.14%** for the benchmark.
- The sectors with the highest contribution to relative return in Q3 were **Communication Services** and **Industrials**.
- The holdings with the highest contribution to Portfolio return were **Fidelity National Financial Inc. - FNF Group (FNF)** and **Alphabet Inc. (CI C) (GOOG)**.
- The sectors with the lowest contribution to relative return in Q3 were **Financials** and **Utilities**.
- The holdings with the lowest contribution to Portfolio return were **T-Mobile US Inc. (TMUS)** and **Progressive Corp. (PGR)**.
- The largest new position added during the quarter was **Keurig Dr Pepper Inc. (KDP)**.

Outlook

- The Portfolio seems well positioned to withstand a multitude of headwinds facing the market, which range from **rising commodity prices and tight labor markets to the fiscal cliff and interest rate uncertainty**.
