Investment Objective

Long-term total return = Russell 1000 Value index plus 200 bps to 400 bps

Strategy Summary

River Road's Large Cap Value Select (LCVS) Strategy is a concentrated, high conviction value strategy comprised of companies that exhibit attractive business models, shareholder-oriented management, and financial strength.

The Strategy's investment universe formally consists of all North American listed equity securities with market caps greater than \$3 B at the time of initial purchase.

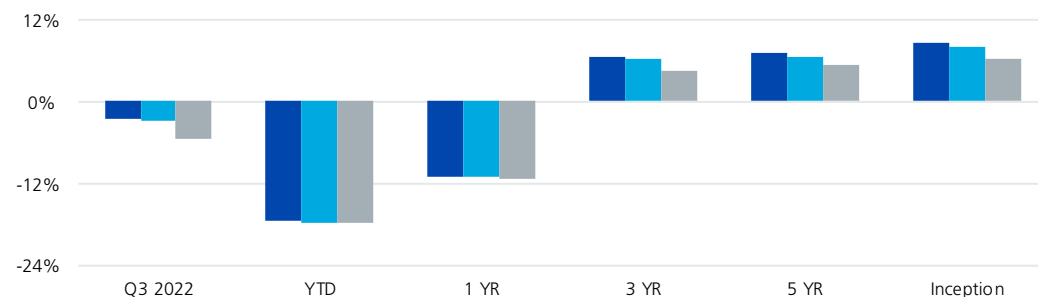

Market Highlights

- Stocks rallied early in the quarter but plunged back into bear market territory as inflation remained hot and the Fed reaffirmed its commitment to conquering it.
- Large caps and value underperformed.**
- Within the Russell 1000 Value index, **Energy (+3.03%)** and **Consumer Discretionary (-2.81%)** had the highest total returns, while **Communication Services (-13.37%)** and **Real Estate (-10.52%)** had the lowest.

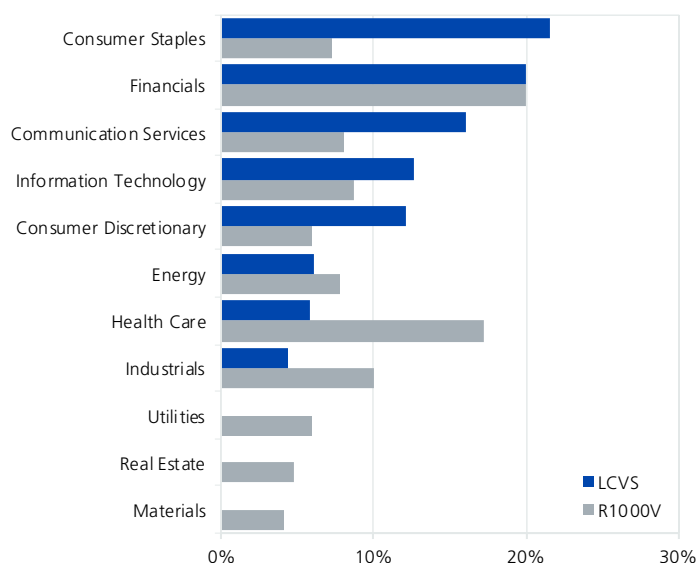
Portfolio Highlights

- The River Road Large Cap Value Select (LCVS) Composite returned -2.69% (-2.73% net) for Q3 versus -5.62% for the Russell 1000 Value benchmark. Year to date, the Composite returned -17.60% (-17.70% net) versus -17.75% for the benchmark.
- The sectors with the highest contribution to relative return (total effect) in Q3 were **Consumer Discretionary (+120 bps)** and **Consumer Staples (+88 bps)**.
- The holdings with the highest contribution to active return were **Starbucks Corp. (SBUX)** and **Ares Management Corp. (ARES)**.
- The sectors with the lowest contribution to relative return in Q3 were **Energy (-71 bps)** and **Industrials (-14 bps)**.
- The holdings with the lowest contribution to active return were **Alphabet Inc. (CI C) (GOOG)** and **Liberty Broadband Corp. (CI C) (LBRDK)**.

Outlook

- Although internal valuations have improved, earnings uncertainty remains, and we feel the Portfolio is balanced with high quality and opportunistic holdings.
